(MAH CR 78 Bridge PID 111521)

Dear Neighbor:

The Mahoning County Engineer in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes to replace the Walker Mill Road Bridge (CR 78) over Yellow Creek in Boardman Township, Mahoning County. Minor permanent and temporary right-of-way may be required. Construction will require closure of Walker Mill Road. A detour will be provided. The project may have impacts to the environment, details of which are unknown at this time but may include regulated materials, historic properties, or stream impacts. Preliminary investigations indicate that the project will involve property which is recorded in your name or where your residence or business is located. Construction is currently scheduled to begin spring 2025 and last approximately 6 months.

As you are a nearby property owner/occupant or interested party we wish to inform you about this project. To ensure the proposed project is viable and successful, the county is seeking comments from the public about the social, environmental, and economic impacts of this proposed project. Environmental impacts include those involving archaeological, architectural, and ecological resources, hazardous materials, and the general location of the project. To ensure your comments may be considered during project development, please submit them no later than September 30, 2022 via the information below:
